



# Source Water Protection Program Terms & Conditions

## Objective:

- To help maintain overall water quality,
- To lessen amounts of nutrients/contaminants entering the groundwater system,
- Improve quality of drinking water.

## Eligibility:

- Project location must be within the La Salle Redboine CD



## Roles and Responsibilities:

### The Applicant Shall:

- Request assistance via the proper application through the Conservation District office;
- Allow consent of entry onto property for purposes of the project;
- In the case of Abandoned Wells: all plumbing and electrical infrastructure must be removed prior to sealing;
- Provide access for inspection, tours or evaluation by CD Board or staff at any reasonable time;
- **Not remove, destroy or alter project without prior authorization of the Conservation District;**
- **Replace at 100% cost if damage to the project is the result of the neglect of any of the preceding;**
- Allow District to place signage at project site for CD contribution to project; signage removal must be approved by the Conservation District prior to removal; and
- **Indemnify and save harmless the District from any and all actions, claims, suits, damages, injuries, or other loss no matter howsoever arising as a result of the construction, operation or maintenance of the project.**

### The CD Shall:

- Arrange for necessary equipment for construction;
- Supervise project to ensure construction is done according to approved project designs;
- Warranty project for a period of 5 years (LSRBCD will not be held responsible for failed water quality testing)

### Project Funding/Cost-Sharing/Incentives:

- The La Salle Redboine CD will fund 70% of the project costs under the Source Water Protection Program up to a maximum that will be determined by the LSRBCD Board on a case-by-case basis.
- Abandoned Wells & Well Shock Treatments will be funded 100% by the LSRBCD with the landowner being charged a \$50 fee per well/treatment.
